What fuels a Spirit-empowered Christ-Follower is more than a plan, but we must be motivated with purpose and passion. We can focus our energy in a moment of life but not know where we are going. In Acts 16:6-10 we see the Apostle Paul and his companions knew the general region where they were headed: Phrygia and Galatia, but the Holy Spirit stopped them from preaching the Word in the Province of Asia. When they came to the border of Mysia they tried to enter Bithynia but the Spirit of Jesus would not allow them. So they left Mysia and went to Troas.





Finally Paul went to sleep. *"During the night Paul had a vision of a man of Macedonia standing and begging him, 'Come over to Macedonia and help us."* Acts 16:9

Paul awakened and concluded that God called him to preach the Gospel to them. You would think that if anyone would know the will of God for certain, it would be Paul. Yet we find that he really had no idea where God was going to lead him. He was proving the will of God.

It is rather humorous to think that he could not determine where God was leading him so he went to sleep!

When he was conscious he couldn't understand. God had to get him unconscious to make it clear!

Many times, we can feel the pressure to tell people things we don't know. Being led by the Spirit is not the ability to define everything the future holds. It is the willingness to move forward because we know that the Lord Jesus Christ is trustworthy, the Holy Scripture gives us clear guidelines and yes, the Spirit in us will direct us.

We don't always know the specific will of God, but by taking incremental steps of obedience to His Word we can prove the will of God (Romans 12:1,2).

What ? I will serve a light breakfast of coffee, tea, juice, fruit and rolls *Where?* Linda Ebel's home (my address & phone number) Rsup? No! Drop in any month you can and any time between 9 & 10:30



I loved having our neighbors over! We averaged from eight to fifteen women each time so I gauged my breakfast to serve 15 or so. By the end of that year our neighbor friends knew each other so much better. Nearly each time one neighbor would linger behind for awhile to ask for prayer. A year after we ended Third Thursday, the Lord led me to begin a weekly Bible study and all nine women I invited said yes to the invitation! We met for three years, two gave their hearts to Christ, and we even did an overnight retreat together. Some are attending my studies now and some have moved away. I love each of these precious friends! Maybe God will lead you to do something similar.
