
Supplying Biblical Resources

Through this connection, we have prayed on our knees in our own homes, *together though apart*, confessing our sins and sins of the nation, we have studied the Ten Commandments, God's abiding moral code, for five weeks, and read them out loud together. We have stood and read out loud Deuteronomy 4:5-8 with a sense of awe, we have shared our steps of obedience with each other and discussed several of my teaching articles on my blog. In the last year the Holy Spirit has prompted me to delve into the Torah (the first five books of the Bible) and in particular the book of Exodus. It is rather staggering how the content of Exodus is profoundly applicable to the realities of life today. I have, on an abundant of occasions, been able to communicate with non-Christians about topics like the sanitary laws in the Bible found in Numbers 19 and in Deuteronomy 23:12; and in Exodus, the proper use of interest, 22:25; the devastation of corruption in a society, 23:8; the danger of taking bribes, 23:8; the vital need for Biblical justice, 23:7, and many more truths germane to our current world! The Lord God, through the Torah, promotes goodness and the attaining of wisdom on a personal level and for any society.

I have been connecting with many people by phone and email. My pastoral role continues as I provide: consulting to pastors and those in life-transitions, marriage counseling, prayer and support for those in grief, and Biblical answers to a variety of questions. Today most of us who name the Name of Jesus Christ would agree that wisdom is lacking in many parts of our culture. It is almost impossible to do good without wisdom. All the good intentions in the world are likely to be worthless without wisdom.

The Torah is a great repository of goodness and wisdom and through it God laid the foundation for the rest of the Bible, through the prophets, Matt. 26:56, the prophecies of the Messiah—Jesus Christ, Isaiah 53, 54, the Psalms, Luke 24:44, for Christianity, Romans 11:11, and for Western Civilization, Matt. 28:19, 20. God gave us “*Love your neighbor as yourself*” in Lev. 19:18, the Ten Commandments in Exodus 20 and Deuteronomy 5, and the knowledge of a just and loving God in Deuteronomy 10:18 and Psalm 36:7.

I suggest that you consider giving new attention to the Torah in your walk with Christ. Several outstanding commentaries that will aid you in your prayerful study are *The MacArthur Study Bible*; *The Henry Morris Study Bible*, *Jon Courson's Application Commentary of the Old Testament*, *Dennis Prager's Commentary on Exodus* (written by a Jew), and the first 32 articles in *The Founders' Bible*. The wealth of applications, knowledge and wisdom will enrich your walk with Christ for years!
